Dear Member / A Chara,

Our club, one of the oldest not only in Dublin but in the country, is rolling out a new plan - 'Towers Abú' - to add to the legacy that we have inherited from previous generations.

This new plan aims to build on the good work that has been done so far by further raising our standards of performance and behaviour, in everything we do, both on and off the field. It will strive to bring consistency to our efforts and establish a 'Round Towers way' of doing things.

This journey commenced before Covid and is the fruit of the labours of many club volunteers, who have brought their professional and personal skill sets to bear on the project for the benefit of the wider club.

The initial steps followed the furnishing and completion of our high performance unit on Monastery Road as we saw a golden opportunity to fully maximise the facility and the impact it could have on the playing of our games in all codes and at all grades.

A Long Term Athletic Development (LTAD) Plan for the whole club followed and the next part of the project is to co-create with our members a roadmap, bringing clarity to what we are trying to achieve as a club and how we will work with each other collectively to be the best that we can be.

Over the course of the process we have identified a new set values for the club and a vision and a mission underpinning a sense of purpose.

The final part of our work will focus on two distinct areas – 1. Culture and 2. Organisational Development.

Success in both of these areas will very much depend on how well we communicate with you, our members, in the coming weeks and months and the engagement this generates.

Already the completion of our high performance facility, the appointment of LTAD partners Armoured Performance and the expansion of the Executive Committee are stand out achievements on the journey and we believe all of these steps combined will enhance the fortunes of the club.

People are at the heart of the model that we are working towards. Our goal is to promote a holistic, whole person-centred approach, with a key focus on Player and Coach Development.

A questionnaire is already in circulation and its findings will feature at club workshops in the coming months. We will be engaging with members and parents in the coming weeks, to provide further details.
